## **Entry Procedures and Entry Fees**

Complete all information on the entry form and sign the Waiver and Assumption of Risk on the form. Athletes under age 18 *must* have the form signed by a parent, guardian, or coach. Unsigned and incomplete forms will be rejected!

## **Entry Fees:**

\$5.00 if received by November 15<sup>th</sup>. \$6.00 if postmarked after November 15 and on race day. Faxed entries will NOT be accepted.

The other five Region I associations – Metropolitan, Maine, Connecticut, Adirondack, Long Island – compete on the same course on November 20, 2005 to earn spots in the Nationals

#### Qualification

The top 3 teams and other individuals in the top 25 at the New England meet qualify <u>directly</u> to the NATIONALS on **DEC. 10**. If a team in the top 3 or an individual in the top 25 chooses not to advance, others *do not move up!* 

#### Waivers - None in 2005

Because of the direct advancement from New Englands to Nationals, we <u>cannot accommodate any waivers in 2005!!</u> This is a National policy.

# Athletes qualifying for and entering the NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP meet must submit the following on November 19<sup>th</sup> before leaving Bryant:

- A completed National entry form with entry of \$8.00 per athlete.
- Proof of age, if not already verified. Bring a nonreturnable copy of birth certificate, baptismal record, driver's license or passport
