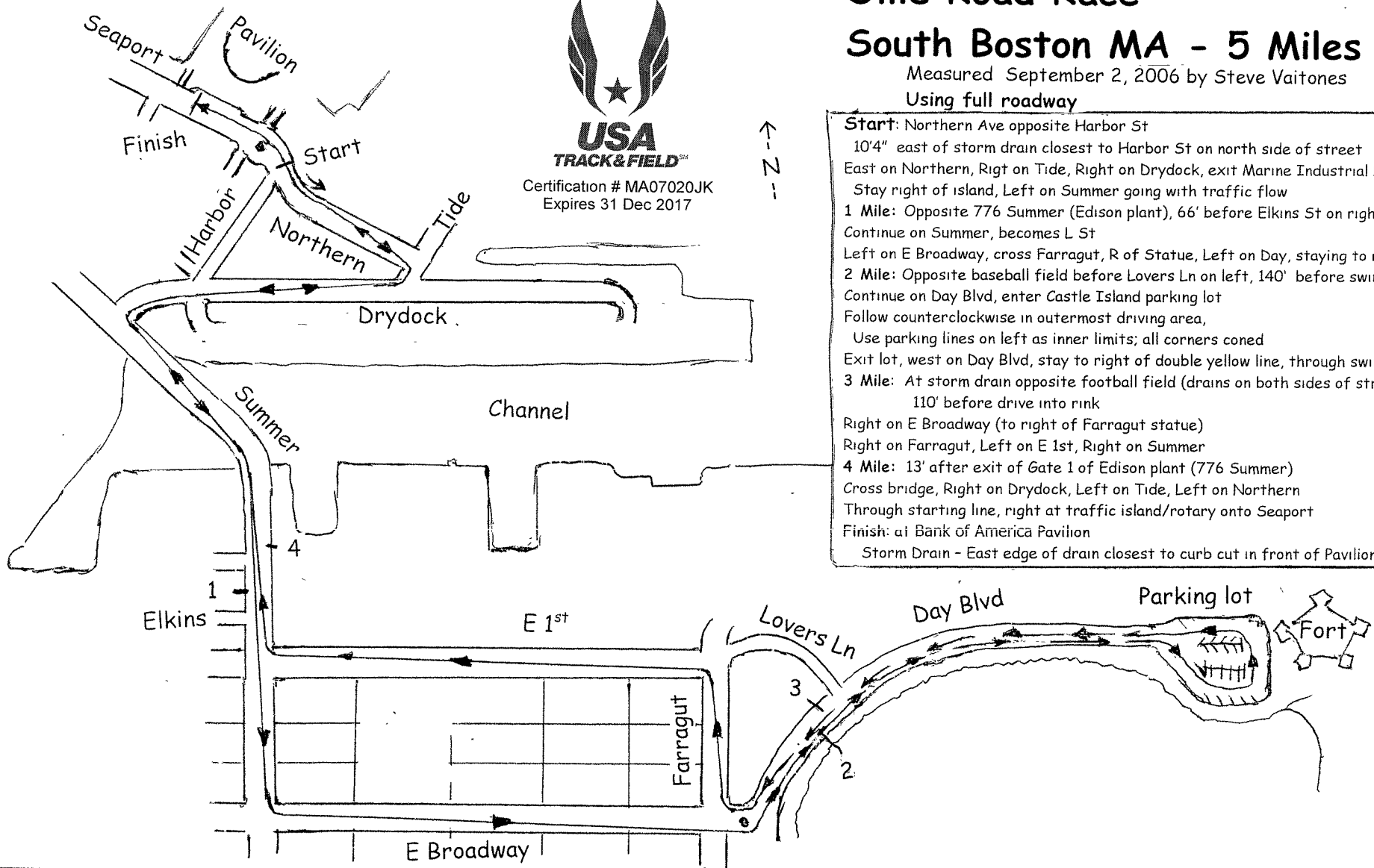
South Boston MA - 5 Miles

- Start:** Northern Ave opposite Harbor St
10'4" east of storm drain closest to Harbor St on north side of street
East on Northern, Right on Tide, Right on Drydock, exit Marine Industrial Park
Stay right of island, Left on Summer going with traffic flow
- 1 Mile:** Opposite 776 Summer (Edison plant), 66' before Elkins St on right
Continue on Summer, becomes L St
Left on E Broadway, cross Farragut, R of Statue, Left on Day, staying to right side
- 2 Mile:** Opposite baseball field before Lovers Ln on left, 140' before swing gate
Continue on Day Blvd, enter Castle Island parking lot
Follow counterclockwise in outermost driving area,
Use parking lines on left as inner limits; all corners coned
Exit lot, west on Day Blvd, stay to right of double yellow line, through swing gate
- 3 Mile:** At storm drain opposite football field (drains on both sides of street)
110' before drive into rink
Right on E Broadway (to right of Farragut statue)
Right on Farragut, Left on E 1st, Right on Summer
- 4 Mile:** 13' after exit of Gate 1 of Edison plant (776 Summer)
Cross bridge, Right on Drydock, Left on Tide, Left on Northern
Through starting line, right at traffic island/rotary onto Seaport
Finish: at Bank of America Pavilion
Storm Drain - East edge of drain closest to curb cut in front of Pavilion
