The winners in each event and the four members of each winning relay team will receive awards. In case the winner is not a USATF-NE member (e.g., a college athlete), an equal award will be presented to the first USATF-NE athlete.

TEAMS

Plaques will be awarded to the New England Champions - men's and women's clubs.

Team scoring is 5 - 3 - 2 - 1, after removing unattached and ineligible athletes.
