Location

M.I.T. Steinbrenner Track, Vassar Street, Cambridge.

Directions: From I-93, take exit 26, and follow the signs to Back Bay along Storrow Drive West, approx. 1.5 miles, to the exit for Rte 2A. The exit will be on the left, just before the Mass. Ave. Bridge. Follow the bridge; Vassar Street is the second street on the left after you cross Memorial Drive.

From I-90 East (Mass. Pike), take the Cambridge/Brighton exit (exit 18). Following the signs to Cambridge, cross the River Street Bridge, and turn right onto Memorial Drive. Turn left at the lights at the Hyatt Hotel, this becomes Vassar Street, bearing to the right.
